Spring EMT Basic Course

Emergency Medical Technician - Basic students are trained to provide basic life support measures such as patient assessment, treatment of shock, oxygen therapy, use of certain medications, bandaging and splinting and emergency childbirth. Students will practice basic skills in small groups. Students must be 16 by the first day of class.

Who Should Attend: Volunteers, Police, Fire, Ambulance, OEM, Ski Patrol & First Responders.

This course starts on Tuesday, January 11, 2011, is held Tuesdays and Thursdays from 7:30 PM to 10:30 PM with some Sunday classes. The course completion date is Thursday, May 5, 2011, with the written test date to be advised. Course graduates are eligible for college credit recommendation.
